

## Using Batteries

Here are some general guidelines for using replaceable AAA batteries.

### When Using Batteries:

- Always insert the batteries correctly, and following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Do not mix new and old batteries (replace all batteries at the same time).
- Do not mix standard, rechargeable and alkaline batteries together.
- Only use the kind of batteries recommended in the User Manual (standard AAA).
- Do not attempt to charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Do not leave dead or depleted batteries inside the product.
- Do not dispose of batteries in a fire, batteries may leak or explode.
- Always remove the batteries from the device before extended periods of storage.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals. If you suspect that your system has shorted-out batteries, do not open the battery compartment until the unit is cool to the touch.
- Do not store conductive or metallic items, (like conductive magnets) loose inside the battery compartment.
- Batteries may leak or explode if misused.
